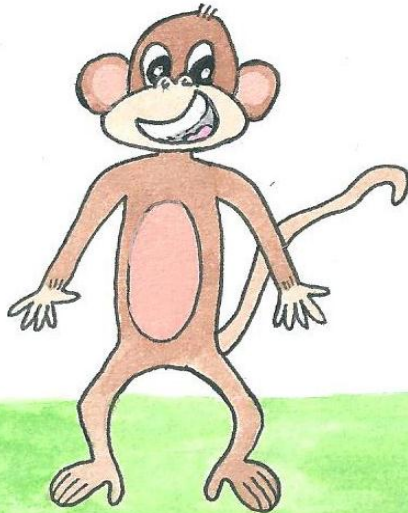
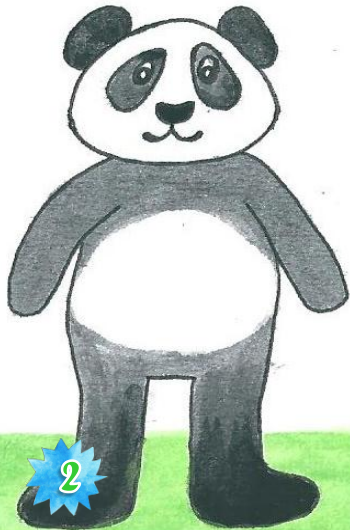

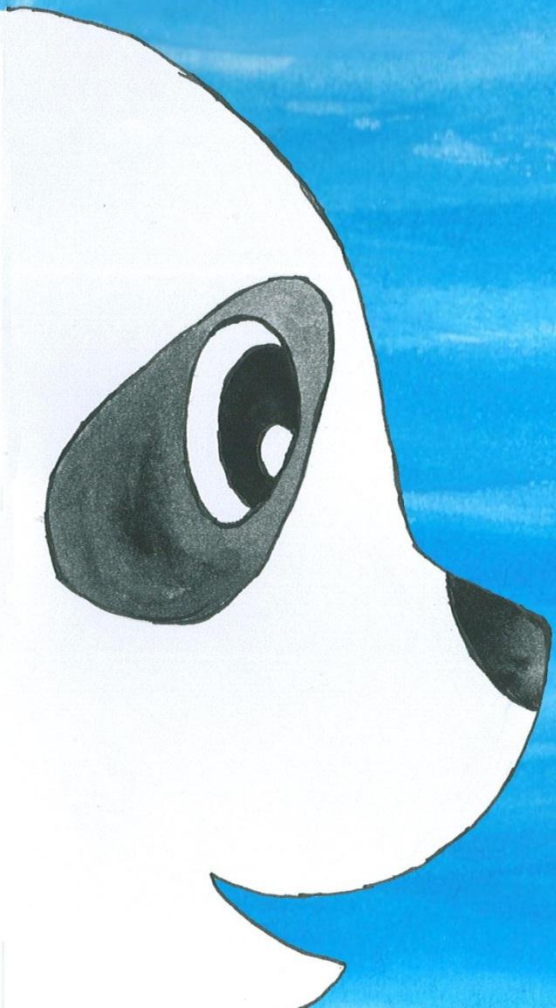

are very good friends.

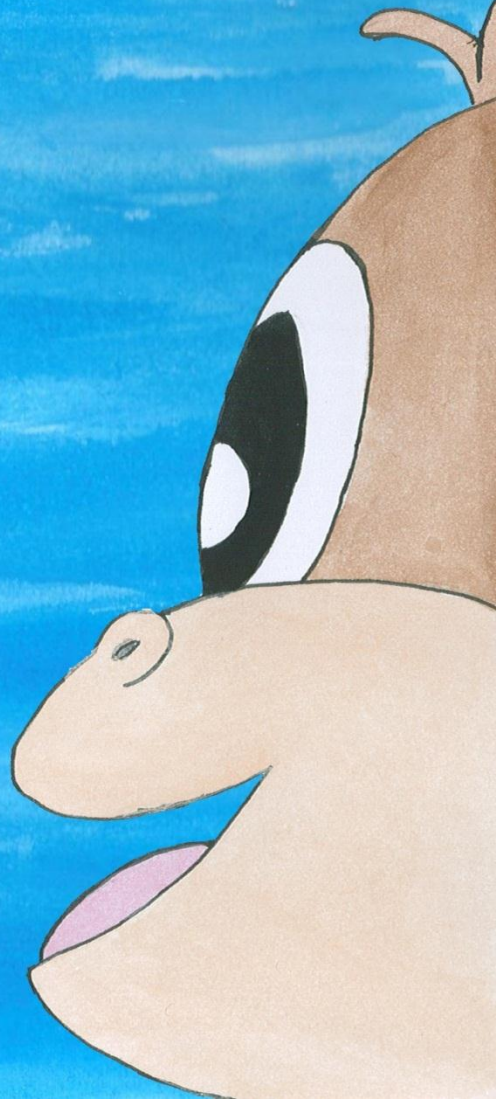
They like to do things together.



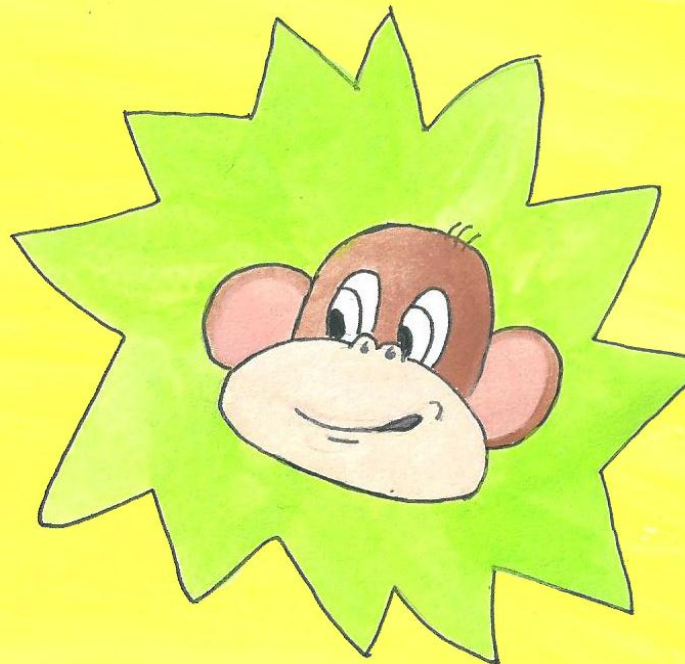
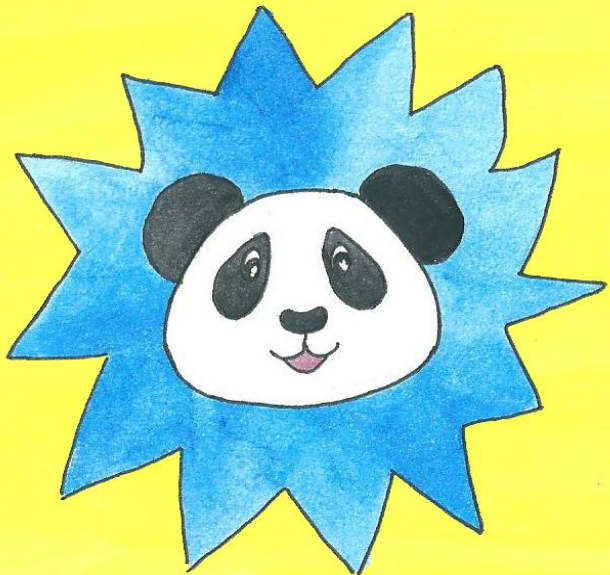

with the other monkeys.”

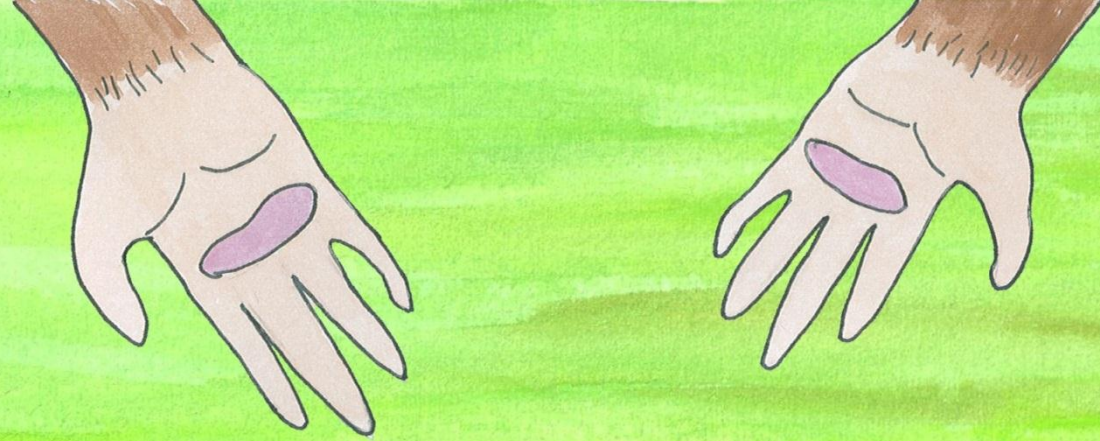


Peter tells Marty, "I want to ride a bike, too. Can you teach me?"



"But you are not a monkey. Can a panda ride a bike?"

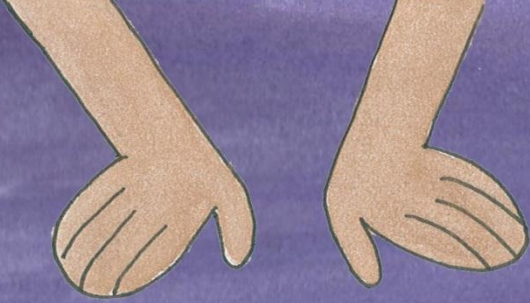
"What do you need to ride a bike?"

"I have two eyes."

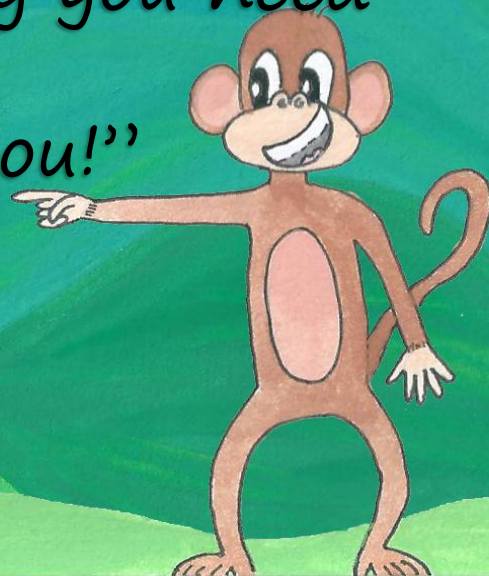




“You need a tail.”
