Part XVI. Vocabulary (page14) (Try to look the new words up in the dictionary.)

	New Words	Sentences / Definitions
1		a piece of clothing worn, especially by men, on the upper part of the body, made of light cloth like cotton and usually having a collar and buttons at the front
2		an outer piece of clothing with sleeves that is worn over other clothes, usually for warmth
3		a piece of clothing for women and girls that hangs from the waist and does not have legs
4		a long, thin piece of material that is worn under a shirt collar, especially by men, and tied in a knot at the front
5		a simple piece of clothing, usually with short sleeves and no collar, that covers the top part of the body
6		pants made of denim (= strong blue cotton cloth) that are worn informally
7		a covering for the head that is not part of a piece of clothing
8		pants that end above the knee or reach the knee, often worn in hot weather or when playing a sport
9		a piece of clothing that covers the lower part of the body from the waist to the feet, consisting of two cylinder-shaped parts, one for each leg, that are joined at the top
10		a strip of leather or material worn around the waist to support clothes or for decoration
11		a piece of clothing for women or girls that covers the top half of the body and hangs down over the legs
12		a piece of clothing that is worn on the hand and wrist for warmth or protection, with separate parts for each finger
